MORE FUNDED CHILDCARE

From September there is a provision for up to 30 hours funded childcare per week subject to the following qualifying criteria;

Children must be aged 3 or 4

Both parents must be working or the sole parent must be working

Each parent must earn, on average, the minimum equivalent to 16 hours at the minimum wage

Earn less than £100,000
